Camp Terms and Client Agreement

ENTRANCE REQUIRMENTS FOR CANINE AND FELINE CAMPERS

- Must be 4 months of age or older.
- Must be spayed or neutered if over 6 months of age.
- Must be current on Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella vaccinations.
- Must be in good health and flea/tick free. If found to have fleas/ticks, preventative treatment will be given at dog owners expense.
- Must be non-aggressive and not toy protective.
- Must have completed application and credit card number(s) on file.
- The Canine Camper must complete interview and Canine Camper Behavioral Interview.

LATE FEES – Your dog will be overnight boarded if you are more than 15 minutes late after closing; you will charged the standard boarding fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY - We ask for you to cancel 48 hours in advance of your day camp or overnight reservation. Day Campers are charged the normal rate for a no-show and boarders are charged a minimum of a two-night cancellation fee. 72 hours notice is required to cancel a holiday boarding reservation without a financial penalty.

AGGRESSIVE DOGS - We do not accept aggressive dogs. Our thorough interview process screens for aggression. If an accepted dog exhibits unacceptable behavior, the dog is given a timeout and the owner is informed of the incident. We will then work with the canine camper owner to resolve the situation or the dog will be asked not to return to day or overnight camp.

VALUABLE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY – The Dog Cabin, LLC and it's employees are not liable to you for your canine/feline camper's personal property damaged, lost or stolen during it's

stay at The Dog Cabin. If you or your pet causes any damage to property or equipment, you will be held liable for replacement costs.

Payment Policy - Fees for Services & Products: The canine camper's guardian agrees to pay for camp fees, services or products with the credit cards listed on the front of this application or by cash or check. By listing your credit cards on the front of this application you are allowing The Dog Cabin to debit your credit card account for services, fees or products. You agree to pay an administrative fee for any returned check, or debit problems, such as non-sufficient funds, closed account, frozen or declined credit or similar circumstances.

Refunds: There will be no refunds on services already provided such as day care, boarding and grooming. Products purchased can be refunded or credited with valid receipt within 30 days of purchase.

Memo of Understanding:

- I understand that The Dog Cabin, its owners and employees, will exercise due care to protect the health and safety of my pet while in their care.
- In the event my pet becomes ill or sustains injury, I have given permission for those in charge to take whatever steps are necessary to obtain medical treatment for my pet, and I agree to pay all charges incurred. I consent to any veterinarian being retained to render care for my pet.
- I understand that, as always, with the interaction of dogs/cats, there is a chance of injury. I assume all risk of injury to my pet while at The Dog Cabin or in transportation to any veterinarian clinic, so long as reasonable care is taken to prevent any unnecessary injury, death, or loss. Also, if I ask for more than one dog/cat to be placed in the same kennel for boarding, I assume liability for any injuries they cause to each other.
- By entering my pet into The Dog Cabin, I hereby waive and release The Dog Cabin, it's owners or employees from any and all liability of any nature for any injury, death or loss of my pet resulting from their actions or from the action of my dog/cat or any other dog/cats while in the custody of, or on the grounds or surrounding area of The Dog Cabin.
- If a life threatening injury or death occurs, The Dog Cabin will notify me immediately to receive specific instructions on how to proceed or to advise me that the camper is being taken to its veterinarian on file.
- In the event my dog/cat causes injury to another dog/cat or to a person while at The Dog Cabin, I agree to indemnify and subrogate The Dog Cabin or its owners from any action, which may be brought against them, and for any defense, settlement, or judgment against them. I will assume all liability for the actions of my dog/cat and agree to maintain personal liability insurance to cover me in the event of such an incident.
